Feedback Report -2021-22

Feedback is an important part of the development of any institution. It helps in showing the pros and cons of the institution, thereby helping the authority take remedial measures on the aspects that show higher level of negative remarks.

Ledo College also conducted a feedback among students, parents and teachers for the year 2021-22 through a set of questions with five options to choose from. Options A and B stand for positive remarks (strongly agree, agree), and options D and E stand for negative remarks (disagree, strongly disagree). Option C stands for neutral (Not sure).

After overall analysis, it is found that 85.8% students have given positive remarks. The percentage of negative remarks is 6.7%, and that of neutral remarks is 7.5%. On the part of parents, 83.1% positive remarks are given, 7.9% neutral remarks are found, and 9% remarks are negative. Positive feedback from teachers is 92.8%, 5.7% remarks are negative, and 1.5% remarks are neutral.

On the basis of the feedback, the institution is trying to take remedial measures for better quality of the institution. It has conducted meetings with teachers, office staff and governing body as to how quality improvement can be done.
